#### CSPA CANADIAN PARACHUTING RECORDS

#### 1. Introduction – FAI Parachuting Records

The Sporting Code of the FAI provides for record classes for individual and group jumps. Records are classified separately as to general and female. Precision and some performance records are also classified as to day and night. For a record to be registered with the FAI as an International or Continental record, the conditions laid down in the FAI regulations must be strictly complied with and a fee paid to the FAI.

#### 2. CSPA Canadian Parachuting Records

CSPA records will not be registered with the FAI, but will be considered as "Canadian" records. The registration and certification of such "Canadian" records will be less complicated. The CSPA records will be classified as Competition Records, Performance Records, and Open Parachuting Records. Current CSPA records are "best performances". Retired records are records which have been superseded by better performances.

#### 2A. Competition Records

- a. Competition records pertain to those events contested at a National Championships or International Sporting Event or any other competition which is governed by the current National or International competition rules (as applicable).
- b. Competition records may only be established during the scheduled competition rounds at a National Championships or at an International Sporting Event or any other competition which is governed by the current National or International rules for that event (as applicable).
- c. Training jumps are not considered to be part of a competition round.
- d. Tie-break jumps are considered to be part of a scheduled competition round.

#### 2B. Performance Records

- a. Performance records pertain to record attempts organized outside of a formal competition setting. They are conducted according to the rules set out for each individual performance category.
- b. One notable exception to statement 2B a. (above) is the Accuracy Landing Consecutive Landings (both A-1A and A-2B), which can be performed during a competition and is governed by the current National or International rules.

#### 2C. Open Parachuting Records

- a. Open records may only be performed in Canada.
- b. 51% of the participants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents and hold a current CSPA affiliation. The remaining 49% may have any citizenship and must hold an FAI affiliated membership and meet local affiliation requirements set by the host DZ.
- c. The Open record category is only applicable to the following Performance record categories:
  - i. FS/VFS Largest Formation, Large Formation Sequential, Full-break Large Formation Sequential (C-2A, C-2C, C-2D, G2, G3, G4, and G5)
  - ii. CF Largest Formation, Large Formation Sequential, Full-break Large Formation (D-4A, D-4B, D-4C)
  - iii. WS Largest Formation no grip, WS Largest Formation Docked (J-6, J-7)

#### 2D. Virtual Competition Records

In years when no Nationals are held, the CSPA will oversee a National Virtual Competition. The main objective of this program is to support local skydivers and to encourage them to train and develop their skills in the discipline of their choice. Using official rules and regulations, skydivers will be able to compete at their own dropzone and submit their performances to be judged remotely. Competitors can team up with former or current National Team members. The event will conclude at the end of the season when winners will be announced. Virtual competition records are eligible in any existing competition record category (in accordance with 2A. above). Each year prior to the commencement of the Virtual Competition, complete details of the rules and draws will be published on the CSPA website. Records can be found in Appendix V of this document.

#### 5. General

- a. For record jumps, all CSPA rules and recommendations must be observed. Refer to CSPA PIM 1.
- b. Records will be classified as follows:
  - general best performance achieved
  - female best performance by a woman, or a team composed only of women
  - each of the above classifications may also have a night classification. Night is considered as one (1) hour after sundown and one (1) hour before sunrise.
- c. A parachute jump record may be established at any time of the year from any kind of aircraft (with the exception of restrictions noted in category C-2B). They can also be made anywhere in the world with the exception of the Open Parachuting Records noted in section 2C above..
- d. For group altitude and group accuracy jumps, the group must jump together from the same aircraft and during the same passage over the target. For FS, VFS, AE, CF and WS jumps, more than one aircraft may be used.
- e. All participants in CSPA records must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents with at least one-year residency and must be Registered Participants of CSPA with the exception of the Open Parachuting Records noted in section 2C above. Camera persons, pilots and judges are exempt of this requirement.
- f. Any record achieved at a Canadian National Championship shall become the current national record. All performances require submission of PIM4D App I and a copy of the score sheet to the CSPA National Office: office@cspa.ca
- g. A record certification by a judge from another country, who has a rating equivalent to a CSPA judge rating as required for each category of record, will be accepted.
- h. An Official who is judging the record performance may not be a participant in the record attempt.
- i. All records are judged according to current CSPA competition rules unless otherwise stated. (Refer to PIM 4B).
- j. All record claims: PIM4D App I Record Registration Form and supporting evidence, as noted in the record categories, and described in Section 22 must be submitted to the CSPA National Office: office@cspa.ca

#### **COMPETITION RECORDS**

#### 6. Accuracy (A-1B and A-2A)

**A-1B Lowest Score** - The individual accuracy record performance for lowest score shall be the lowest total score achieved in a ten round competition.

**A-2A Lowest Score Team -** The record performance of a team is the lowest total score of the team after a completed competition program of 8 rounds.

- In a group jump, the performance shall be the number of consecutive landings on the disc of the whole group, plus the total distance of the next group jump not on the disc.
  - o The jumps must be made within a period of 7 days.
  - o The Record Jump series may not be interrupted by other accuracy jumps.
- Individual and group accuracy jumps may be made from any altitude above ground between 760 m (2,500') and 1,200 m (4,000').
- The jumps shall be measured with an automatic measuring device, having a dead centre disc of 2 cm diameter.
- Accuracy records may be set during the day or night. Night is defined as the period between one hour after official sunset and one hour before official sunrise.
- The number of parachutists in a group for accuracy jumps may be four or five. When five parachutists are used, the highest score in a round shall be discarded.
- The Performance must be judged and certified by at least three judges, two of whom must hold as a minimum a Provincial Accuracy rating.

#### 7. Style Jumps (B-1A and B-1B)

**B-1A Time for one jump** - The record performance for a style jump shall be the time for one jump. The jump must be one of the currently accepted FAI series.

**B-1B Total lowest score** - The record performance of an individual is the final score after a completed competition program of five rounds as defined in the current FAI Competition Rules.)

- The performance for B-1A and B-1B will be evaluated in accordance with the current FAI rules for the Style event.
- Style jump records may only be established during the scheduled competition rounds at an International or World Championships, where a ground-to-air video is the primary judging means.
- The Performance must be judged and certified by at least three judges, two of whom must as a minimum hold a Provincial Style rating.

#### 8. Formation Skydiving (C-1 & C-5) and Vertical Formation Skydiving (C-4 & C-6)

- C-1 FS Longest Sequence the record performance of the longest sequence shall be the number of formations completed in accordance with the current rules for the FS event. The records shall be classified separately for four and eight person teams and may include the videographer, if appropriate.
- **C-4 VFS Longest Sequence** the record performance of the longest sequence shall be the number of formations completed in accordance with the current rules for the VFS event. The records may include the videographer.
- C-5 FS Highest Average the record performance for the highest average is the average number of formations for a completed competition program of 10 rounds as defined in the current Competition Rules. The average must be calculated by dividing the final total point score (excluding any tie-break jumps) by 10.
- C-6 VFS Highest Average the record performance for the highest average is the average number of formations for a completed competition program of 10 rounds as defined in the current Competition Rules. The average must be calculated by dividing the final total point score (excluding any tie-break jumps) by 10.
  - The record performance for the longest sequence and highest average may only be established during the scheduled competition rounds at a National, International or World Championships, where an air-to-air video is the primary judging means.
  - The record performance for the longest sequence and highest average must be evaluated and certified by at least three judges, two of whom hold as a minimum a Provincial FS rating.

#### 9. Formation Skydiving – 10-way Event – Time to Star (C-3)

- The record performance shall be carried out according to the competition rules (PIM 4B Formation Skydiving Chapter 8 10way Speed).
- The record performance shall be the time in which 10 jumpers form a complete 10-way star.

The exit altitude shall be as stated in the competition rules.

- The record performance must be judged using air-to-air video.
- The record performance must be certified and evaluated by at least three judges all of who must have at least a valid Provincial FS rating.
- A record performance submitted under this category shall not also be submitted under category C-7.

#### 10. Canopy Formation (D-1, D-2, D-3, D-5, D-6, D-7, D-8, D-9)

- **D-1 4way Rotation** the record performance for four-way rotation shall be the number of points scored in accordance with the current rules for the four-way rotation event.
- **D-2 8way Speed Formation** the record performance for eight-way speed shall be the time taken to complete an 8-way formation in accordance with the current rules for the 8-way speed event.
- **D-3 Longest Sequence (4way Sequential)** the record performance for the longest sequence shall be the number of points scored in accordance with the current rules for the four-way event.
- **D-5 Longest Sequence (2way Sequential)** the record performance for the longest sequence shall be the number of points scored in accordance with the current for the two-way event.
- **D-6 Longest Sequence (2way Sequential) Pro-Am** the record performance for the longest sequence shall be the number of points scored in accordance with the current for the two-way event.

- **D-7 Highest Average (4way)** The record performance for the highest average is the average number of formations for a completed competition program of 8 rounds as defined in the current Competition Rules. The average must be calculated by dividing the final total point score (excluding any tiebreak jumps/performances) by 8.
- **D-8 Highest Average (2way)** The record performance for the highest average is the average number of formations for a completed competition program of 8 rounds as defined in the current Competition Rules. The average must be calculated by dividing the final total point score (excluding any tiebreak jumps/performances) by 8.
- **D-9 Highest Average (2way) Pro-Am** The record performance for the highest average is the average number of formations for a completed competition program of 8 rounds as defined in the current Competition Rules. The average must be calculated by dividing the final total point score (excluding any tiebreak jumps/performances) by 8.
  - The record performance for all CF records must be evaluated and certified by at least three judges, two of whom hold as a minimum a Provincial CF rating.

#### 11. <u>Canopy Piloting (I-1A, I-1B, I-1C, I-3A, I-3B, I-3C)</u>

- **I-1 Distance** Negotiate a parachute through an entry gate and continue flying for as far a distance as possible before touching the surface. Current FAI Canopy Piloting course specifications and performance requirements apply.
  - i) **I-1A Max Distance** The record performance is the greatest distance achieved in any round of the CP Max Distance Event in accordance with the competition rules.
  - ii) **I-1B Drag Distance** The record performance is the greatest distance achieved in any round of the CP Drag Distance Event in accordance with the competition rules.
  - iii) I-1C Full Drag Distance The record performance is the greatest distance achieved in any round of the CP Full Drag Distance Event in accordance with the competition rules.
  - The performance must be judged and certified by three judges, two of who must hold as a minimum a Provincial CP rating.
- **I-3 Speed** Negotiate a parachute through an entry gate and continue flying the parachute through the course and through the exit gate in as fast a time as possible. Current FAI Canopy Piloting course specifications and performance requirements apply.
  - i) I-3A Max Speed 50m the record performance is the lowest time achieved in any round of the CP Max Speed 50m Event in accordance with the current competition rules.
  - ii) **I-3B Carved Speed 70m** the record performance is the lowest time achieved in any round of the CP Carved Speed 70m Event in accordance with the current competition rules.
  - iii) I-3C Drag Speed 50m the record performance is the lowest time achieved in any round of the CP Drag Speed 50m Event in accordance with the current competition rules.
  - The performance must be judged and certified by three judges, two of whom must hold as a minimum a Provincial CP rating.

#### 12. Wingsuit Records (J-1 through J-3)

- **J-1 Distance:** The record performance for distance is the greatest horizontal distance achieved in any round of the Distance Task in accordance with the current Competition Rules.
- **J-2 Speed:** The record performance for speed is the fastest speed achieved in any round of the Speed Task in accordance with the current Competition Rules.
- **J-3 Time:** The record performance is the longest time achieved in any round of the Time Task in accordance with the current Competition Rules.
  - Performances must be certified by two judges who hold as a minimum a valid Provincial WS Performance rating.

#### PERFORMANCE RECORDS

#### 13. Accuracy (A-1A and A-2B)

- **A-1A** The individual accuracy record performance for consecutive landings shall be the number of consecutive landings on the dead centre disc, plus the distance of the next jump not on the disc.
- **A-2B** In a team jump, the performance shall be the number of consecutive landings of the whole team on the dead centre disc, giving an aggregate score of zero centimetres, plus the next score made.
  - a. The record must be made by a team of the same four individuals for the whole record.
  - b. The jumps must be made within a period of 7 days.
  - c. The Record Jump series may not be interrupted by other accuracy jumps.
  - d. The number of parachutists in a group for accuracy jumps may be four or five. When five parachutists are used, the highest score in a round shall be discarded.

# 14. <u>Formation Skydiving - Largest Formation (C-2A, C-2B) and Large Formation Sequential (C-2C and C-2D)</u>

#### C2A and C2B Largest Formation

The record performance for the **FS** Largest Formation shall be the number of persons in one formation. A diagram showing the formation to be attempted must be submitted to the judges in advance. The formation must be completed as described with all named persons in the formation.

All persons in the completed formation must be connected by at least one grip either taken by the person or taken on the person. A grip is a handhold on an arm or leg (both as defined in the relevant Competition Rules) of another person.

• The aircraft used for the FS Largest Formation (C2-B) shall be restricted to having a single, piston-driven engine and each aircraft shall be allowed to carry no more than six participants.

#### C-2C Large Formation Sequential and C-2D Full Break Large Formation Sequential

The record performance for Large Formation Sequential and the Full Break Large Formation Sequential is the number of persons (not less than 25% rounded up) of the size of the Largest Formation record at the time the sequential record is performed to complete a sequence of two or more formations, giving a separate record performance for the total number of formations completed.

A written plan (drawings) describing the formations and transitions to be attempted and the persons involved must be submitted to the judges in advance. The formations and transitions must be performed as described in the plan.

All persons in the completed formations must be connected by at least one grip either taken by the person or taken on the person. A grip is a handhold on an arm or leg (both as defined in the relevant Competition Rules) of another person.

#### **C-2C – Large Formation Sequential**

In the transition from one formation to the next, at least 35% of the persons in the first formation must either:

- i. release all of their grips and all grips on them must also be released, or
- ii. be a member of a released sub-group consisting of no more than four persons.

**None** of the released grips included in this 35% may be retaken in the next formation.

Each subgroup must be clearly presented and remain intact as a subgroup from the grip release until the correct completion of the next formation. Simultaneous separation during the transition is not required but total separation must be shown at some point in time during the transition as shown in the written plan.

In order to assist in understanding the transition requirements, the following explanation is given: Assume a 50 way has been built. To properly achieve the transition to a second 50 way point, at least 18 persons must hold no grips nor have grips taken on them (i.e. be separated from the formation) at some point in time during the transition (simultaneous separation, as in 4 way and 8 way is not required) OR be part of a sub-group (no larger than 4 persons) that has separated from the formation. This can be achieved by having 18 individual persons separated or having 4 sub-groups of 4 persons plus 2 individual persons or some combination of individual and sub groups in between these two extremes. For example, there could be 9- 2 way groups or 6- 3 way groups.

#### C-2D – Full Break Large Formation Sequential

In the transition from one formation to the next, all grips must be released. No new grip may be taken by any person until all grips held by or on that person have been released. Simultaneous separation between persons is not required.

None of the grips may be retaken in any of the subsequent two formations in the sequence. Where a grip is on an arm or hand it will be considered the same grip no matter which person has taken the grip.

After the group has completed three different formations, the group may elect to return to the first formation allowing the first set of grips to be retaken) and repeat the sequence or may elect to continue the sequence with three, new different formations.

#### 15. Formation Skydiving – 10-way Event – Time to Star (C-7)

- The record performance shall be the time in which 10 jumpers form a complete 10-way star. All persons in the completed formation must be connected by at least one grip either taken by the person or taken on the person. Grips are defined in the current FS competition rules (PIM 4B). The formation does not have to be held for five seconds.
- There is no restriction on the exit altitude. Exit procedures shall be as stated in the competition rules (PIM 4B Formation Skydiving Chapter 8 10way Speed).
- There is no restriction on the working time.
- The record performance must be judged using air-to-air video.
- The record performance must be evaluated and certified by at least two judges. Only one judge needs to be on site. Judges must have, as a minimum, Formation Skydiving Provincial FS rating.

#### 16. Canopy Formation – Large Formation (D-4A) and Large Formation Sequential (D-4B and D-4C)

**D-4A** - The record performance for the **CF** Largest Formation shall be the number of persons in one formation. A diagram showing the formation to be attempted must be submitted to the judges in advance. The formation must be complete as described with all named persons in the formation.

All persons in the completed formation must be connected by at least one grip either taken by the person or taken on the person. Grips are as defined in the current CF competition rules (PIM 4B).

#### D-4B Large Formation Sequential and D-4C Full Break Large Formation Sequential (D-4C)

The record performance for the CF Large Formation Sequential (D-4B) and Full Break Large Formation Sequential (D-4C) shall be the number of persons (not less than 25% (rounded up) of the size of the Largest Formation record at the time the sequential record is performed) to perform a sequence of two or more formations, giving a separate record performance for each number of formations completed.

A diagram showing the formations and the transitions to be attempted and the persons involved must be submitted to the judges in advance. The formations and transitions must be completed as described with all named personnel in the formations.

All persons in the completed formations must be connected by at least one grip either taken by the person or taken on the person. Grips are as defined in the current CF competition rules (PIM 4B).

#### **D-4B - Large Formation Sequential**

In the transition from one formation to the next, at least 35% of the persons in the first formation must either:

- i. release all of their grips and all grips on them must also be released, or
- ii.be a member of a released sub-group consisting of no more than four persons.

Each person or group must re-dock in a different position or on a different set of grips.

Each subgroup must be clearly presented and remain intact as a subgroup from the grip release until the correct completion of the next formation. Simultaneous separation during the transition is not required but total separation must be shown at some point in time during the transition as shown in the written plan

#### D-4C - Full Break Large Formation Sequential

In the transition from one formation to the next, all grips must be released. No new grip may be taken by any person until all grips held by or on that person have been released.

Simultaneous separation between persons is not required.

None of the depicted grips from any previous formation may be retaken in the same position in any of the subsequent formations in the sequence for up to three formations. Each person must redock in a different position or on a different set of grips.

After the group has completed three different formations, the group may elect to return to the first formation and repeat the sequence (allowing the first set of grips to be retaken) or continue the sequence of formations with a new, different formation.

#### 17. Altitude (E-1, E-2)

#### E-1 - Altitude Individual and E-2 - Altitude Group

- The record performance of an altitude jump shall be the altitude above ground level at which the parachutist(s) exit the aircraft.
- The altitude must be certified by the pilot of the aircraft or an independent observer who accompanies the aircraft on the record attempt.
- Altitude jump records shall be beaten only if there is a difference of at least two percent greater altitude.
- Altitude records shall be classified separately for day and night. Night is defined as the period between one hour after
  official sunset and one hour before official sunrise.
- The number of parachutists in a group for altitude jumps shall be four.
- The record performance must be certified by at least one judge who holds as a minimum a Provincial judge rating.

#### 18. Cross-Country Canopy Descents (F-1)

- **F-1** The performance record for cross-country shall be the distance traveled by an individual parachutist, while under a conventional sport canopy (not a tandem canopy), from the point of aircraft exit to the first point of contact with the surface measured in a straight line.
  - The distance traveled may be determined by using a portable Global Positioning System (GPS) from which exit and landing points can be calculated. The readings indicated by the GPS unit shall be used to determine the straight-line distance traveled.

- The distance traveled may also be determined by a Position Logging Device (PLD) worn by the performer. The PLD must be turned on by the judge immediately prior to the performer boarding the aircraft and must remain in the 'on' position until returned to the judge after landing. The pilot will verify the PLD is in the 'on' position prior to exit from the aircraft.
- Cross-country canopy descents may be made from any altitude above the ground but the exit altitude must be certified by the pilot.
- The performance record must be evaluated and certified by at least one judge with a Provincial rating or higher. The judge will be present at the landing site to verify the point of landing and confirm the readings of the GPS and/or to take possession of the PLD and confirm it has remained in the 'on' position. The pilot will monitor and certify the GPS readings at time of exit.
- Cross-country records shall be beaten only if there is a difference of at least two percent (2%) longer distance.
- No performance record shall be accepted unless complete data is provided on the calculation of distance traveled and the figures used to determine that data. The distance travelled will be calculated to kilometers
- Cross-country canopy descents from higher altitudes may require special pre-planning and coordination with both the pilot and air traffic control when descents are through controlled air space.
- The record performance must be certified by at least one judge who holds as a minimum a Provincial judge rating.

# 19. <u>Vertical Formation Skydiving – Largest Formation (G-2, G-3), Large Formation Sequential (G-4),</u> and Full Break Large Formation Sequential (G-5)

G-2 and G-3 – The record performance for the **Vertical Largest formation** shall be the number of persons in one formation. A diagram showing the formation to be attempted must be submitted to the judges in advance. The formation must be complete as described with all named persons in the formation with grips as defined in the current competition rules.

- G-2- Head Down the torso is vertical with head down, towards the ground
- G-3 Head Up the torso is vertical with head up, towards the sky

#### G-4 Vertical Formation Skydiving Large Formation Sequential

The record performance for **Large Formation Sequential** (G-4) is the number of persons (not less than 20% rounded up – of the size of the Largest Formation record at the time the sequential record is performed. to complete a sequence of two or more formations, giving a separate record performance for the total number of formations completed.

A written plan (drawings) describing the formations and transitions to be attempted and the persons involved must be submitted to the judges in advance. The formations and transitions must be performed as described in the plan.

All persons in the first formation must be connected by at least one grip either taken by the person or taken on the person. All persons in formations following the initial formation must be connected by at least one grip either taken by the person or taken on the person in groups of no less than 25% of the initial formation or 8 people (whichever is larger).

A grip is a handhold on an arm or a leg of another person (as defined in the current Competition Rules PIM 4B). If a grip is taken on a particular arm or leg, then moving that grip to another arm or leg attached to that particular arm or leg will not be considered a new grip for the purpose of determining the number of changed grips between formations.

In the transition from one formation to the next, at least 25% of the persons in the subsequent formation must build a new grip that differs from the previous formation.

No repeated formations will be allowed.

#### G-5 - Full Break Large Formation Sequential

In the transition from one formation to the next, all grips must be released. No new grip may be taken by any person until all grips held by or on that person have been released. Simultaneous separation between persons is not required.

None of the grips may be retaken in any of the subsequent two formations in the sequence. Where a grip is on an arm or hand it will be considered the same grip no matter which person has taken the grip.

After the group has completed three different formations, the group may elect to return to the first formation allowing the first set of grips to be retaken) and repeat the sequence or may elect to continue the sequence with three, new different formations.

#### 20. Most Jumps done in a 24-hour Period (H-1A, H-1B)

#### H-1A – Round Parachutes and H-1B – Square Parachutes

- The record performance for most jumps done in a 24-hour period will be recorded for a single jumper. Multiple sets of parachuting gear, planes, and pilots may be used.
- The total number of jumps counted will be those recorded after the first declared jump exits the plane. There must be clear communication between the pilot and the officials on the ground as to when the jumper first exits the plane.
- The last jump in the 24-hour period will be that in which the jumper actually touches the ground within the official time period.
- Category H1A will be for round parachutes. Category H1B will be for square parachutes.
- The performance must be judged and certified by at least two judges, both of whom must have a valid Provincial rating. At all times, one of the judges must be designated as an Observing Judge to determine that the canopy is deployed at the proper altitude as set out in PIM 1, Basic Safety Rules and Recommendations. A record of start time, exit times, landing times and end time must be submitted with PIM 4D App I.
- There will be a Safety Officer present for the duration of the record attempt. More than one Safety Officer can be used
  and it will be recorded on the record application who acted as the Safety Officer during which period of the record attempt.
  If at any time the Safety Officer feels safety would be compromised for any reason, he/she will stop the continuance of
  the record attempt.

#### 21. Wingsuit (J-4, J-5, J-5A, J-6, J-7, J-8)

For WS records, all persons must wear a wingsuit, which complies with the definition in the FAI Sporting Code Section 5 1.1.2 (15) and the use of a drogue is not allowed.

**J-4 Wingsuit Time of Fall Record**: The record performance is the time of fall, measured in seconds, while wearing a wingsuit, from exit altitude to the altitude at which the fall is terminated as measured by the required equipment as described below.

The Wingsuit time of fall/distance of flight record is to be determined using an appropriate flight recorder, Position Logging Device (PLD). The record file submitted must contain:

- a. Calibration data to substantiate the accuracy of the data submitted, including the margin of error.
- b. Evidence that the data cannot be and has not been tampered with between the time it is recorded and the time it is handed over to an Official Observer.
- c. Evidence that the instrument registers and provides the type and accuracy of data required to determine the record performance.
- **J-5 Wingsuit Distance of Flight Record**: The record performance is the straight-line distance of flight, measured in metres, to three decimal places, while wearing a wingsuit, from exit altitude to the altitude at which the fall is terminated as measured by the required equipment as described above.

A new Wingsuit distance of flight or Wingsuit time of fall record is set only if the lower limit of the error range of the record performance is greater than the upper limit of the current record error range by at least 2%. No means of propulsion may be used after leaving or jettisoning the device by which the individual or team has been carried to the exit altitude.

**J-5A Horizontal Speed:** The record performance will be the highest instantaneous horizontal speed achieved from exit altitude to the altitude at which the fall is terminated as measured by the required equipment. The highest instantaneous horizontal speed will be expressed in kilometers per hour (km/h) measured relative to the ground.

Performances (J-4, J-5, J-5A) must be certified by two judges who hold as a minimum a valid Provincial WS rating. Only one judge needs to be onsite.

#### J-6 Largest Formation - No Grips:

- A) The record performance for the **Wingsuit Largest Formation** shall be the number of persons (minimum 8) in close formation, without grips that is performed in horizontal orientation and evaluated in accordance with the current WS Largest Formation Performance Record Rules.
- B) The record performance for the **Wingsuit Largest Formation** shall be the number of persons (minimum 8) in close formation, without grips that is performed in vertical orientation and evaluated in accordance with the current WS Largest Formation Performance record Rules.

#### J-7 Largest Formation – Grips:

The record performance for the **Wingsuit Largest Formation** shall be the number of persons (minimum 4) in one formation. The formation must be 100% complete with grips as defined in the current competition rules. A diagram of the formation to be attempted must be submitted to the judges in advance. The formation must be 100% complete.

#### J-8 Large Formation Sequential WS No Grip

- (a) The record performance is the number of persons (not less than 8) to complete a sequence of two or more wingsuit formations, giving a separate record performance for each number of formations completed.
- (b) In consecutive formations, at least 75% of the persons must move to a new designated flying space in the grid.
- (c) After the group has completed three different formations, the group may elect to return to the first formation and repeat the sequence.

See the current Wingsuit Acrobatic Competition Rules for definition of grips.

For further information, see the Wingsuit Largest Formation Performance Record Rules by the ISC Wingsuit Flying Committee and available for download from the FAI website: fai.org/parachuting and Sporting Code Section 5.

## 22. <u>Judges/Officials for Largest Formation (C-2A, C-2B & C-2C, C-2D, D-4A, D-4B, D-4C G-2, G-3, G-4, J-6, J-7, and J-8); Most Jumps done in a 24 hour period (H-1A+B)</u>

Upon application from the participants before the record attempt, the CNTC, (through the Chair), may authorize the record performance to be certified by three responsible officials, who are not rated judges as required above. The CNTC will have the authority to determine who are considered responsible officials; (for example, CSPA coaches, officers, etc. would be acceptable). The officers can verify the paperwork, participants and collect media evidence of the performance. They will then be responsible for ensuring all documentation is sent to the pre-arranged judges. Performances will not become official records until judged by a panel of at least two appropriately rated judges. Completion photographs and video evidence will be included in the submission to the CSPA Office.

The record performance must be evaluated and certified by at least two judges. Only one judge needs to be on site. Judges must have, as a minimum, one of the following ratings for the respective discipline being challenged

- i. Formation Skydiving Provincial FS rating.
- ii. Canopy Formation Provincial CF rating.
- iii. Vertical Formation Skydiving -Provincial FS rating.
- iv. Wingsuit -Provincial WS rating.

#### 23. Registration

- a. Registration of the record performances must be submitted by using Form F114 (Appendix I), which is available on the <a href="mailto:CSPA website">CSPA website</a> or from the CSPA National Office: office@cspa.ca
- b. Registration forms for record performances achieved at competitions must be accompanied by the score sheet signed by the Chief Judge and/or the official scores posted online by the appropriate authority.
- c. Largest formation records and large formation sequential records registration requests must be accompanied by:
  - i.a participant(s) list which includes name, mailing address, CSPA number and expiry date, and CoP number, preferably on an Excel spreadsheet.
  - ii. a diagram of the performance, where applicable
  - iii. A digital photograph(s) of completed formation(s) and video evidence from exit to break off where applicable.
  - iv. Duly completed and signed F114 (Appendix I)
- d. Record submissions with incomplete information/evidence will be returned to the judges named on the registration form.
