## **Instructions for Riggers**

Effective January 1, 2024, riggers will be required to complete and submit the Rigger Rating Maintenance and Revalidation Form with their annual CSPA Affiliation Renewal. Changes have been made to the annual requirements specific to rigger rating levels. Requirements to keep accurate logs in the event a request is made by the CSPA or any Canadian Government agency to view them continues to be required.

CSPA intends to evaluate these requirements on an annual basis. Any comments or suggestions can be sent to michelle@cspa.ca and will be disseminated to the appropriate team members.

#### Instructions for the signing authority

The intention is that CSPA Riggers and CSPA DZOs can be signing authorities for these requirements. It is expected that you verify logs before signing any maintenance and revalidation requirements.

Signing for Ratings that the person does NOT have will cause this form to be rejected by the National Office.
